## What is a CTP?

A CTP is a long-range evaluation of existing and future transportation needs.

It explores how to provide the best travel choices for residents and employers in a growing region.



## What is a CTP?

A CTP is **multi-modal**, meaning that it will focus on:

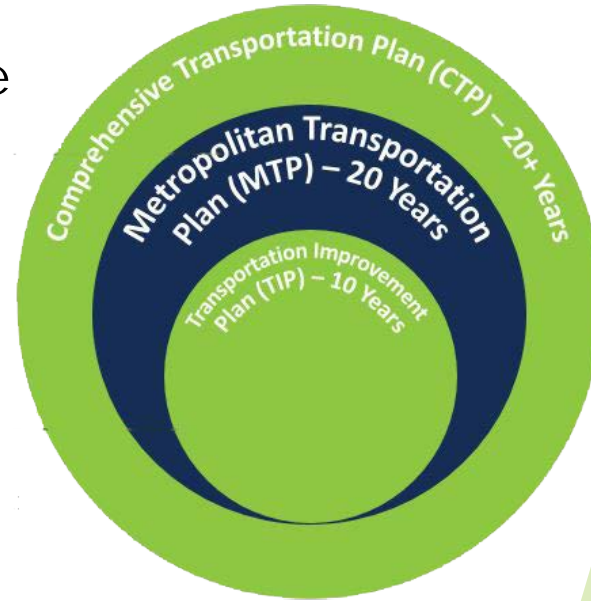
- highways
- bicycle facilities
- sidewalks
- trails
- public transportation
- rail



Attention to each of these transportation modes allows us to better provide for a fuller range of transportation choices. The CTP will ultimately replace the ***Thoroughfare Plan***, which considers only highways and does not assess existing conditions.

## Why is our CTP important?

- The CTP will provide a broad and thorough vision for our transportation future
- It will be periodically updated to keep pace with our growing region.
- It identifies future transportation needs
- And it makes recommendations to resolve those needs
