1	What do you see we have done right so far in the first 7-8 months of this process (keep in mind we have another 12-15 more to go)?	good pace, scheduling, adapting to virtual, good group of people, good topics, good organization, great leader (Dana), good communication among group.
2	What do you wish we should or can be doing differently?	reduce email traffic (new link on CRTPO site will help). Remote meetings are a huge challenge, not sure if there is anything to do about it. Clarification about the role of the group, and what we can do or can't do. better preparation prior to discussions/meetings. Rich is unsure of how the recommendations will be taken by TCC/Board.
3	Is the one meeting a month good with you (too much, not enough)?	one meeting is fine, a second only as needed.
4	What if it were meetings twice per month (June and July)?	same as above
5	Are you more concerned or interested in the current topic (CTP amendment) or the next topic (white paper recommendations)?	50/50 or both
6	Do you feel we are allowing enough time during the meetings for each discussion, and capturing everyone's input?	90 min is fine. 60 min was too short.
7	Will you say only a couple of people have too much input over the discussions?	Not an issue. Some people talk more than others. Some are subject experts in key areas. Group allows for all to provide input.
