#### CTP Amendment Guidelines Recommendations

Several changes were suggested and done during the meeting.

## **Levels of Public Engagement Draft**

All CTP guidelines and public involvement requirements need to be in one location. They will be included in the PIP. The guidelines can be added as an appendix if needed.

Administrative amendments will not requirement public engagement. The WG will continue to review the wording for recommended or required public notification/information about administrative amendments.

It was agreed that the WG needs to start defining <u>major vs minor</u> amendments and the appropriate level of public engagement related to type of amendment.

#### **Unadopted CTP Amendment Process**

The WG briefly reviewed the unadopted CTP amendment process provided and agreed this is a good start. There was discussion about the benefit of requesting the Board to open the period for procedural amendments. It was determined that this step is needed so all jurisdictions are aware of proposed changes, especially if it impacts their jurisdiction. Additional discussion will continue at a later meeting.
